About the ADN Program

Registered nurses administer nursing care to ill and injured persons. The majority of jobs are in hospitals and clinics, but opportunities are also available in public health, education, and industrial settings. As the population ages and the nursing workforce nears retirement, there is a significant demand for nurses regionally, and in California. Because of the serious responsibilities of registered nursing, and to fulfill the legislated mandates of the California Board of Registered Nursing, the SRJC ADN program is a very rigorous, sequential, four semester nursing education which requires full-time attendance to meet the required program hours and course student learning objectives. The successful completion of this major entitles the student to an Associate of Science Degree in Nursing, and eligibility to take the NCLEX-RN, the professional state licensing examination to become a registered nurse.

Preparing to Apply for the ADN Program

It is strongly advised that all applicants attend a Counseling Pre-nursing Information Meeting (dates are posted on the ADN website) and consult with a health sciences counselor at the SRJC Counseling Department prior to beginning the program prerequisites or to have individual transcripts or coursework evaluated. Course substitutions should be reviewed by a Counselor. Program requirements are subject to change and students are strongly advised to consult with their counselor regarding all requirements. The ADN administration/admissions does not evaluate transcripts prior to admission.

Application Procedure

- The SRJC ADN Program application is a <u>hard copy admissions packet</u>. All completed applications, <u>with unopened official transcripts</u>, must be received by 5:00pm PST on the deadline date. INCOMPLETE or LATE Application WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 2. ALL sections of the application should be completed and submitted for consideration for admission.
- 3. Applicants will be notified via email of the status of their application on or before June 30, 2023. ADN Admissions Selection Process

The provisional admission of ADN students is based on the completed application, the Community College Chancellor's Office qualification screening criteria, student space available, and random lottery results.

- For all applicants except LVN 30-unit option, qualification screening for admission will be based on a 1 probability of student success score. The score will be determined by a formula using the following four criteria:
 - a. Overall College GPA for the past five years (note: if less than 24 units have been completed in the past five years the full college GPA will be used)
 - b. GPA in English 1A (or equivalent course) which must be completed prior to applying for the nursing program.
 - c. Overall GPA within the Core Science prerequisites (anatomy, physiology, and microbiology) within the past five years.
 - d. Minus one point for each Core Science repetition
- 2. If there are more qualified candidates than 60 student spaces for each semester, all screened candidates with a probability of success score of 80% or better will be selected for provisional admission by a randomized lottery.
- Completion and documentation of all prerequisites with official college transcripts. "In Progress" grades 3. WILL NOT be accepted.
- 4. All required prerequisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

TEAS Testing Requirement

In addition to completion of course prerequisites, all provisionally accepted applicants must meet eligibility requirements for admission including completion of the current version of the ATI TEAS exam with a score of 62% or higher. Please indicate your TEAS status:

<u>Provisional to Confirmed Admission</u> Students selected by the lottery and accepted with provisional admission must satisfy ALL additional requirements to confirm admission space for their selected semester start by the stated deadlines indicated in the provisional admission letter. Because of area hospital policies, students who are provisionally accepted are required to have all health requirements met, including full immunization, a clear background check, and a clear drug screen prior to acceptance into the program. Hospitals have the right to refuse students placement if unvaccinated or with criminal convictions. Students who are restricted from area hospitals will not be accepted into the ADN program because course/program objectives cannot be met. Students with a positive drug screen are prohibited from being placed in clinical agencies and therefore will not be admitted into the ADN program. Please refer to the Health Requirements and Background and Drug test policy on the ADN website for further information.
